



Publication and Copyright Terms of Agreement

Manuscripts may only be submitted for consideration of publication in the Journal for Advancing Justice (journal) if the work contained therein has not previously been published and is not under consideration for publication by another journal, book, or monograph. Upon acceptance for publication, the author and co-authors assign to the journal the right to publish and distribute the manuscript in part or in its entirety. The author's and co-authors' names will always be included with the publication or distribution of the manuscript.

The author and co-authors certify that they have participated sufficiently in the development of the work presented to be listed as authors and that they have met at least two of the following criteria. They have:

- (1) Conceived and designed the work;
- (2) Analyzed and interpreted the data;
- (3) Drafted and reviewed substantial portions of the article for intellectual content; and/or
- (4) Read, revised if necessary, and approved the final version of the manuscript to be published.

The author and co-authors have the following non-exclusive rights:

- (1) To use the manuscript in their teaching or professional presentation activities;
- (2) To re-publish the manuscript (with appropriate acknowledgment) or permit its republication as part of a book, book chapter, or monograph the author or co-authors may write or edit;
- (3) To include the manuscript in the author's or co-authors' own personal or departmental (but not institutional) online database or websites;
- (4) To republish the manuscript on a public-access online database if supported by federal funding and if required to do so as a condition of funding; and
- (5) To permit reprints of the manuscript to be distributed by third persons for educational photocopying.

The author and co-authors also agree to properly credit the Journal for Advancing Justice as the original place of publication of the manuscript.

The author and co-authors hereby grant the journal full and exclusive rights to publish the manuscript if accepted. The journal rights include but are not limited to the following:
