- Operations Manual The operations manual outlines the rules, procedures, and
 expectations of the treatment court. Reading it ensures you understand how the court
 operates, your responsibilities on the team, and how to support participants effectively
 and consistently. It's your roadmap for making informed decisions and contributing to
 positive outcomes.
- Participant Handbook The participant handbook explains the program's structure, rules, and expectations from the participant's perspective. Reading it helps you understand the participant journey, the phase requirements, and the challenges they may face. This knowledge allows you to support participants effectively, provide consistent guidance, and contribute to better outcomes.
- Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) The MOU outlines all treatment court team
 members' roles, responsibilities, and expectations. Reviewing and signing it ensures you
 understand your obligations, how your work fits within the team, and the standards for
 collaboration and accountability. This helps maintain a cohesive, effective team and
 supports consistent, fair treatment for participants.
